

### Existing MacKey Skate Park Area

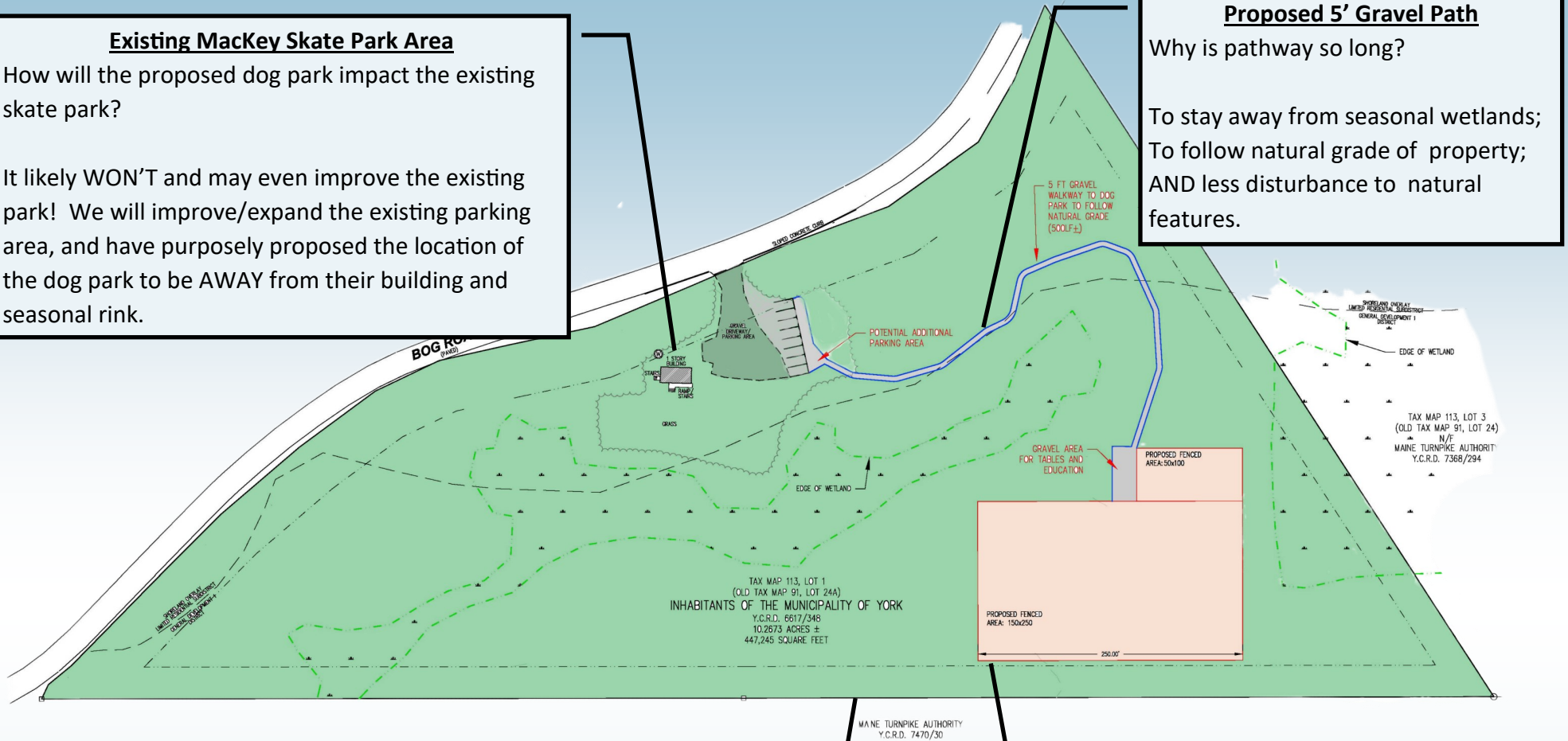
How will the proposed dog park impact the existing skate park?

It likely WON'T and may even improve the existing park! We will improve/expand the existing parking area, and have purposely proposed the location of the dog park to be AWAY from their building and seasonal rink.

### Proposed 5' Gravel Path

Why is pathway so long?

To stay away from seasonal wetlands;  
To follow natural grade of property;  
AND less disturbance to natural features.



### 17 Bog Road, York, Maine

How did the FOYDP end up at this location?

In 2019, a group of interested citizens approached the Town of York Board of Selectmen with an idea to build a community, public dog park for all. Through a joint effort between the Town of York and the Friends of York Dog Park several locations were researched. The conclusion was 17 Bog Road was the best location for a Community Dog Park. After obtaining a professionally designed site plan, at the May 22, 2021 Town Meeting, FOYDP successfully obtained voter approval to lease the property. Now we need to raise the funds to construct the park!

### Enclosed Dog Park Area

How big is it going to be and why 2 areas?

We've designed the enclosed dog park to be approximately an acre in size. The larger pen is for bigger dogs and contains approximately 37,500 square feet, and the smaller pen is for smaller dogs and contains approximately 5,000 square feet. There will also be a "holding area" for transitioning into either pen. Depending on fundraising— the size of these pens may be SMALLER to start with.
